Additive Mission:

- **Expected 50% population increase 3500+ starting in 2019 (currently ~6800 personnel)**
 - **~600 arrive Fall 2020 & rest by Fall 2021**
- **Eielson AFB will increase by 50+ aircraft beginning in 2020**
- **Two new F-35 Squadrons by 2022**

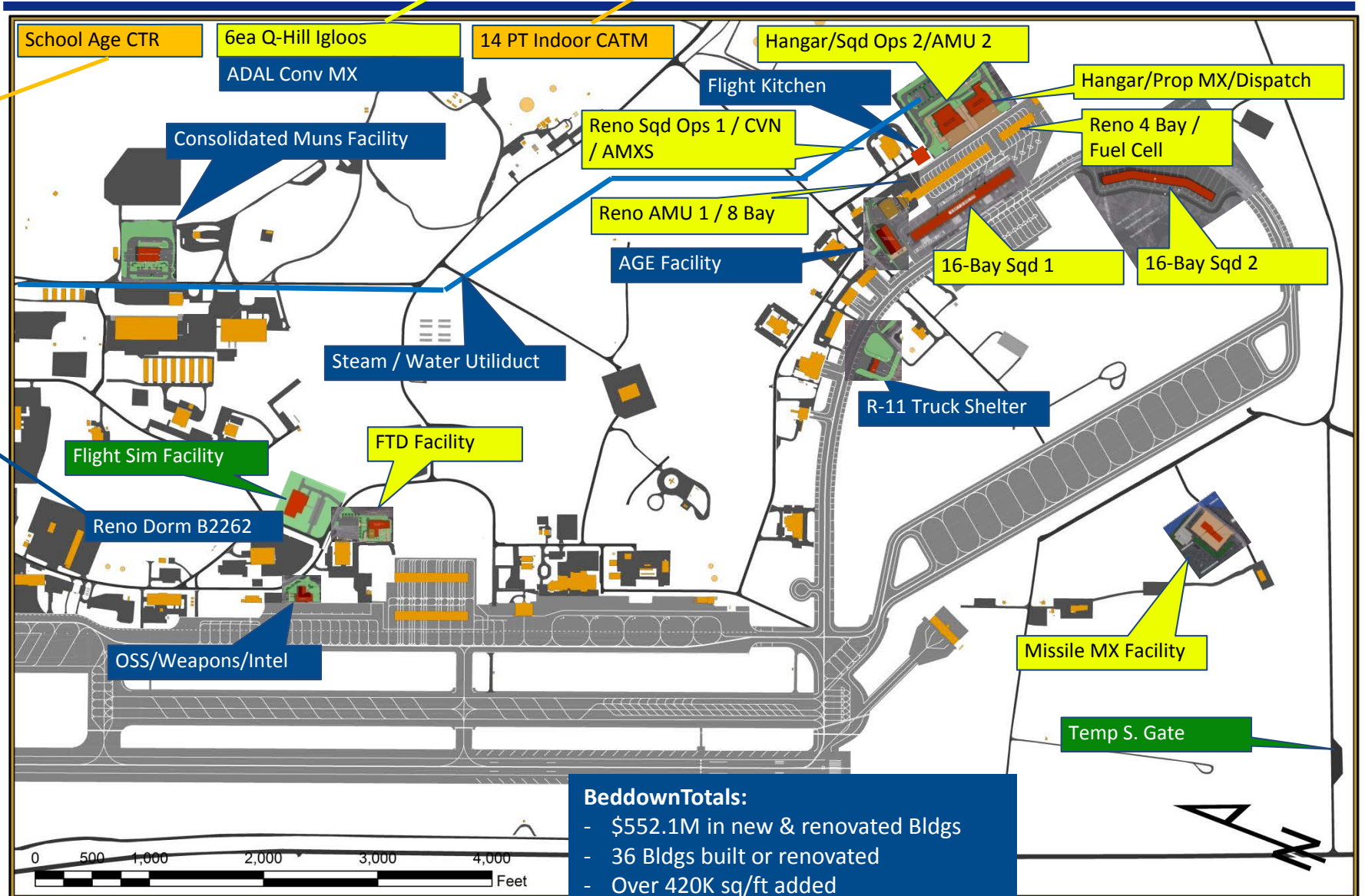
